SHORT TERM MEMBERSHIP RULES

Short Term Membership

A Club Officer, or member of the Management Committee, may admit into temporary membership persons with sailing interest. They will be allowed to participate in Club activities (subject to any contrary ruling by the Management Committee).

They will pay a fee per person, per day. There will also be a charge for a boat space in the Dinghy Park. The fees will be fixed by the Management Committee, at their discretion, without reference to a General Meeting.

They will have full use of Clubhouse facilities within the context of House Rules.

They will have no voting rights in the Club.

They will have no right to introduce visitors.

They will not be eligible to collect race trophies restricted to Club members.

They may have the right to boat storage on the Club dinghy park, subject to available space and payment of fees.

They will not have the right to use the Club owned boats.

When the Club sponsors events, or makes its facilities available for the use of other organisations involved with boating, those taking part will be **Short Term Members** for the duration of the event, and their names and addresses shall be recorded in the Visitors Book.
